THURSDAY, OCTOBER 9

Home—Charlotte, N.C.



“Boogity...boogity...boogity, let’s go racing!” And, we’re off for a week-end of racing fun. Depart from Manchester, NH airport (schedule to be advised) for a quick flight to Charlotte, N.C. Upon arrival, meet our local guide and time permitting, check into the Uptown Hampton Inn. Then it’s off to Lowe’s Motor Speedway for your first glimpse of the action!

With a large majority of NASCAR teams based within 30 miles of Lowes Motor Speedway, this is truly the heart of NASCAR country. Since 1960, this famous 1.5 mile quad-oval has hosted some legendary races. In addition to the 1.5-mile quad oval, the Lowe's Motor Speedway complex includes a 2.25-mile road course and a six-tenths-mile karting layout in the speedway's infield; a quarter-mile asphalt oval utilizing part of the speedway's front stretch and pit road; and a one-fifth-mile oval located outside turn three of the super speedway. Three NASCAR NEXTEL Cup Series events, two NASCAR Busch Series races and a NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series event are among the major events held on this track.

Start your evening with an included dinner at the Speedway Club. Located high above Lowe's Motor Speedway front stretch, the Speedway Club's dining room offers the area's finest cuisine along with a spectacular view of the legendary track. Your evening at the track continues with Pole Night racing. With one of the richest pole awards of the season on the line, sparks are sure to fly as the NASCAR Sprint Cup Series drivers challenge each other. Meal: D



FRIDAY, OCTOBER 10

Nationwide (Busch) Series Race

After breakfast at your hotel, depart for a first-hand view of the racing operations of some of your favorite teams. Visit Hendrick Motorsports, home to Jeff Gordon, Jimmie Johnson & Dale Earnhardt, Jr.; Roush-Fenway Racing, home to Carl Edwards & Matt Kenseth; and Ganassi Racing, home to Juan Pablo Montoya & Reed Sorenson.



A box lunch will be provided while we travel the short distance to Michael Waltrip’s Raceworld USA. Raceworld USA is a revolutionary NASCAR experience that allows an insider’s look at the garage shop areas such as engineering, gears and transmissions, shocks and suspension. Receive a tour of a race transporter which carries race cars to the track and view a motor home used by the drivers while at the track. From heavy fabrication of the frame to the placement of the last decal, learn how hundreds of people work together to reach the same goal...Victory!

After a quick return to the hotel, depart for the Nationwide (Busch) Series Race at Lowe’s Motor Speedway...Where Racing Lives! Enjoy pre-race festivities and dinner on your own at the track. Cheer for your favorite race team from your Grand National Tower seats. Meals: B, L



SATURDAY, OCTOBER 11

Sprint (Nextel) Cup Race

Begin your day with a visit to JR Motorsports, the Busch Series shop of Dale Earnhardt, Jr. Then, tour Pit Instruction and Training Facility, a private pit crew facility owned by Jeff Hammond of Fox Sports. View a private demonstration of how pit crews prepare for and accomplish their stops on pit road on race day. Meet the pit crew, ask them questions, and handle the jack, air wrench, and tires! After an included BBQ lunch, return to hotel and get ready for the BIG race.

The excitement builds this afternoon as your Lowe's Motor Speedway experience continues with a pre-race visit to pit road. Request autographs and watch as team members prepare for the battle ahead. Then, the chase is on for the SPRINT (NEXTEL) CUP title! Sit in premium Veranda seats located towards Turn One (Section B / Rows 36-39). Your comfortable outdoor stadium-style seats with contoured backs and armrests offer a full view of the track and the exit from pit road. Charlotte—Home

After checking out of your hotel, take a motorcoach tour of “the Dale Trail” in Kannapolis, Dale Earnhardt Sr.’s hometown. Reservations and Payments:

Reservations will be accepted subject to availability at the time of a request. Deposit is due within 5 days of confirming a tour reservation. \$300 per person deposit due to confirm space
Final payment is due by August 8, 2008.
Payment can be made in person or by phone. Checks, Cash, VISA or MasterCard are accepted.

Cancellation Charges:

If you cancel for any reason prior to tour departure, the cancellation fees are as follows:
After deposit is made and prior to the final payment date, your deposit is non-refundable.
After the final payment date, your full payment is non-refundable.

Name Changes / Transferring Reservations:

There is no charge for name changes / reservation transfers on multi day tours if the change is made 60 days or more prior to departure.

Within 60 days of departure on a multi day tour, all rules of the tour operator, airlines and cruise lines will be in effect. In addition, there is a \$50.00 per person administration fee.

Tours Do Include:

Transportation, services, meals, lodging, sightseeing and entrance fees to attractions as stated in the itinerary, and taxes and gratuities for included services unless otherwise indicated.

Tours Do Not Include:
