Reservations and Payments:

Reservations will be accepted subject to availability at the time of a request. Full payment is due within 5 days of confirming a tour reservation. Payment can be made in person or by phone. Checks, Cash, VISA or MasterCard are accepted forms of payment.

Cancellation Charges:

If you cancel for any reason prior to tour departure, your payment is non-refundable, unless a replacement can be found for you.

Name Changes / Transferring Reservations

There is no charge for name changes/reservation transfers on any 1-day tour.

Tours Do Include:

Transportation, services, meals, lodging, sightseeing and entrance fees to attractions as stated in the itinerary, and taxes and gratuities for included services unless otherwise indicated.

Tours Do Not Include:

Sightseeing, entrance fees or meals (unless specifically listed in the itinerary as included) all items and expenses of a personal nature and gratuities to tour directors, coach drivers or local area guides.

Trip Cancellation Protection:

Optional cancellation insurance is strongly recommended.
