SATURDAY, August 8

Early morning departures are planned from Berlin and Littleton. Sit back and relax on-board your luxurious motorcoach as you begin your overnight get-away with your Plymouth Travel Tour Director. Stops will be made for rest breaks and lunch along the way.



Upon arrival in Quebec City, there will be an Orientation Tour of the city and, time permitting, some free-time in the Petit Champlain neighborhood of Old Quebec. Later this afternoon, attend “Cirque 2009,” a celebration of the 25th Cirque du Soleil show in 25 years. Cirque du Soleil began in 1984 with 20 performers and now has grown to 900 artists who hail from 40 different countries. They have thrilled over 50 million spectators in more than 100 cities on four continents and have won many prestigious awards. This new, compelling show raises its big top at Quebec City’s Old Port with artistry that will take you to new heights and incredible acrobatic feats that defy gravity.

After an included dinner, check into your deluxe hotel, Hilton Québec, located steps from the Old City. Enjoy the hotel’s fine amenities such as the lounge, indoor pool, jacuzzi and fitness room, or simply relax and enjoy the hotel’s superb location with magnificent views of the St. Lawrence River, Old Québec, the Laurentian Mountains and Parliament.

Reservations and Payments:

Reservations will be accepted subject to availability at the time of a request. Deposit is due within 5 days of confirming a tour reservation.
\$150 per person deposit due for multi day tours of 2-6 days.
\$350 per person deposit due for all tours 7 days or longer.
Unless specified, final payment for all tours is due 45 days prior to tour departure.
Payment can be made in person or by phone. Checks, Cash, VISA or MasterCard are accepted.

Cancellation Charges:

If you cancel for any reason prior to tour departure, the cancellation fees are as follows:
More than 90 days prior to departure, your deposit is fully refundable
90 days or less prior to departure, your deposit is non-refundable.
Less than 45 days prior to departure, your full payment is non-refundable.

Name Changes / Transferring Reservations:

There is no charge for name changes / reservation transfers on multi day tours if the change is made 45 days or more prior to departure.

Within 45 days of departure on a multi day tour, all rules of the tour operator, airlines and cruise lines will be in effect. In addition, there is a \$50.00 per person administration fee.

Tours Do Include:

Transportation, services, meals, lodging, sightseeing and entrance fees to attractions as stated in the itinerary, and taxes and gratuities for included services unless otherwise indicated.

Tours Do Not Include:

Sightseeing entrance fees or meals unless specifically listed in the itinerary as included, all items and expenses of a personal nature and gratuities to tour directors, coach directors or special guides.

Accommodations:

Accommodations are based on double occupancy. Single rooms are limited. Triple/quad rooms usually have two double beds. Many hotels have additional charges for a rollaway bed.

Baggage Allowance:

Each traveler may bring one large suitcase and one carry-on bag small enough to fit in the overhead rack on board the coach.

Trip Cancellation Protection:

Optional cancellation insurance is strongly recommended. Participants are urged to review their insurance requirements with their personal insurance agent or consider the Access America (AM) policy available from Plymouth Travel. AM provides coverage for cancelled and interrupted trips, medical costs, travel accidents and lost/stolen baggage. Gratuities are included for the wait staff of included meals. The customary end-of-tour gratuities to the driver and tour director are voluntary and should be given on an individual basis for a job well done. Suggested amounts: \$3 per person per day to each the Driver and the Tour Director.

Due to the volatility of fuel costs, our contracts with airline, cruise lines, and motorcoach companies includes their right to increase their charges based on unanticipated increases in fuel prices.

Travelers with Special Needs:
