Reservations and Payments:

Reservations will be accepted subject to availability at the time of a request. Full payment is due within 5 days of confirming a tour reservation. Payment can be made in person or by phone. Checks, Cash, VISA or MasterCard are accepted forms of payment.

Cancellation Charges:

If you cancel for any reason prior to tour departure, the cancellation fees are as follows:

More than 90 days prior to departure, your payment is fully refundable

90 days or less prior to departure, your payment is non-refundable, unless a replacement can be found for you.

Tours Do Include:

Transportation, services, meals, lodging, sightseeing and entrance fees to attractions as stated in the itinerary, and taxes and gratuities for included services unless otherwise indicated.

Tours Do Not Include:

Sightseeing entrance fees or meals unless specifically listed in the itinerary as included, all items and expenses of a personal nature and gratuities to tour directors, coach directors or special guides.

Accommodations:

Accommodations are based on double occupancy. Single rooms are limited. Triple/quad rooms usually have two double beds. Many hotels have additional charges for a rollaway bed.

Baggage Allowance:

Each traveler may bring one large suitcase and one carry-on bag small enough to fit in the overhead rack on board the coach.

Trip Cancellation Protection:
